

## **UNIT TITLE:** EMERGING AS A SONGMAKER

Mix it Up

Throughout this lesson block students:

- Notate and record melodic and lyrical ideas into DAW.
- Investigate methods of working with a DAW in the editing and mixing phase that includes:
  - o Exploring sounds and textures through the use of native and synthesised instruments
  - o Experimenting with plugins and effects to create timbral change, and alter dynamics and expression, including reverb, equalization, compression and delay.
  - o Experimenting and manipulating samples and loops to create original material

Lesson Objectives	<ul> <li>Experiment and create notated or recorded methods of song writing</li> <li>Experiment with and evaluate the use of Digital Audio Workstations (DAW) in developing and enhancing musical ideas</li> <li>Experiment with expressive devices and DAW plugins to enhance timbral, expressive and textural qualities of song</li> <li>Design a workflow and create song forms and ideas on DAW of choice</li> </ul>
