

## **UNIT TITLE:** EMERGING AS A SONGMAKER

Year 9 and 10 Music

Writing Time

Throughout this lesson block students:

- Work collaboratively toward developing a coherent song that brings together all members ideas from the individual song formative task.
- Evaluate the elements of each group members musical ideas in the selection and application of song elements that can form a new musical idea and song form.
- Record and notate the final song within the group on a DAW.

Allow appropriate class time for students to refine song, presentation and production of the song on the DAW for final submission.

Time Allocation	11 - 12 Lessons (12.5 hours)
Lesson Objectives	<ul> <li>Create song with a minimum of three distinct sections (e.g. a Verse, Chorus and a Bridge) that are arrange to develop a complete song</li> <li>Develop the song within a group to include three contrasting harmonic progressions and three contrasting melodic phrases (with lyrics)</li> <li>Record or notate the song on a DAW or in journal</li> </ul>
	This lesson has a <b>critical thinking</b> and <b>creativity, personal and social capability</b> and <b>ICT capability</b> focus:
Underpinning General Capabilities	<ul> <li>give reasons to support their thinking, and address opposing viewpoints and possible weaknesses in their own positions</li> <li>reflect on feedback from peers, teachers and other adults, to analyse personal characteristics and skill sets that contribute to or limit their personal and social capability</li> <li>critically analyse self- discipline strategies and personal goals and consider their application in social and work-related contexts</li> <li>explain how relationships differ between peers, parents, teachers and other adults, and identify the skills needed to manage different types of relationships</li> <li>critique their ability to devise and enact strategies for working in diverse teams, drawing on the skills and contributions of team members to complete complex tasks</li> <li>develop and apply criteria to evaluate the outcomes of individual and group decisions and analyse the consequences of their decision making</li> <li>select and use ICT to articulate ideas and concepts, and plan the development of complex solutions</li> </ul>
